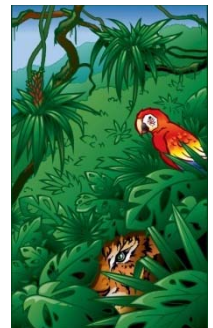
**Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup>**

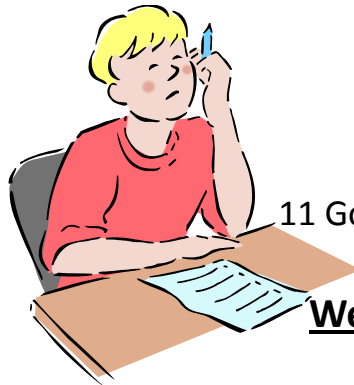


## **Wild West Trip Fundraisers**
