The money is due to the office no LATER than April 23<sup>rd</sup>. Cost - \$20, which includes pizza and Castles & Coasters.

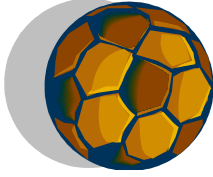

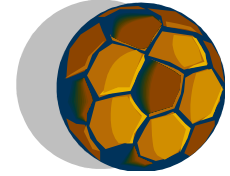
